**SCHEDULE & SUPPLIES!**

**SUPPLIES:** You provide markers, a home-made card and 2 snacks. We will pre-purchase a Gift Bag, Door Hanger, Canvas. COST is \$5 for supplies provided.

**Gift Bag / Door Hanger / Canvas -**

Decorate in Patriotic Colors of Red, White, and Blue. Can include a message such as "Thank you" or "God Bless America." Also suggested using cheerful symbols/emojis such as Sunshine, Heart, Rainbow, Flower. Can use Sharpies / Markers for all art projects. If you have paint and wish to paint the canvas, that is also ok.

**Thank You Card –**

We recommend using a piece of light color construction paper and folding it in half to make a large work surface for your card. Use big print. Address your card in this way:

Dear Veteran (or) Dear Friend

From: First Name, Last Initial

**IMPORTANT!** Please DO NOT seal your card closed. Please DO NOT sign with your full name, just First Name, Last Initial.

**2 Individual Size Snacks –**

We recommend avoiding peanuts or sticky ingredients like caramel, opt for thin/crispy such as potato chips, and soft like Little Debbie or similar cakes.

One of each is preferred, one salty snack, one sweet snack.
